SECOND AWARD OF THE DARLING FOUNDATION PRIZE.

The Director of the Health Section, secretary of the Darling Foundation Committee, has the honour to inform you that the Foundation Committee met on November 1st, 1937, to make the second award of the Foundation prize.

In accordance with the statutes of the Foundation, amended by the Health Committee in conformity with the provisions of Article 1\* at its twenty-fifth session (April 1937), the Foundation Committee consisted of the Chairman of the Health Committee, Professor PARISOT, the two Vice-Chairmen of the Health Committee, Dr. JITTA and Dr. MORGAN, the Acting Chairman of the Malaria Commission, Lieut.-Colonel SINTON, and the Director of the Health Section in his capacity as Secretary.

After examining the different candidatures submitted by the health administrations and by the members of the Health Committee and of the Malaria Commission, the Committee decided to award the Foundation prize to Professor N. H. SWELLENGREBEL.

The ceremony of awarding the medal will take place during the Third International Congress on Malariology, to be held at Amsterdam in September 1938.
