NUCLEAR COMMITTEE ON MALARIA

First Session: Geneva, 21-24 April, 1947

DRAFT AGENDA

I. New antimalarials:

- (a) Present state of our knowledge.
- (b) Problems still outstanding and deserving of the Committee's special attention.
- (c) Programmes for co-ordinated and strictly controlled experiments to be carried out in several countries on the Committee's suggestion; choice of the countries and the malariologists that are to conduct the experiments, working out of the methods to be adopted, supervision of the work, and financial assistance.

II. Larval control by DDT:

- (a) Indication of the data to be collected on the anti-larval campaigns with DDT which will be carried out in the various countries with a view to gathering comparable information, for the eventual preparation of a comprehensive report on this subject.
- (b) Selection of the health administrations and institutes to whom application for these data can appropriately be made.
- (c) Suggestions for the nomination of the rapporteur.

III. Control of adult anopheles by DDT or gammexane:

- (a) Problems still outstanding and deserving of the Committee's special attention.
- (b) Indication of the data to be collected in the various countries where this method of malaria control is employed with a view to their utilization in the eventual preparation of a comprehensive report.

(c) Selection of the health administrations and institutes to which application for these data should be made, and which should be requested to furnish progress reports as promptly as possible, prior to publication, with special reference to the organization of the campaign and the cost per square metre of walls treated.

IV. Advanced training of the malariologists in charge of malaria control or of instruction in malariology:

Programme of fellowships to be submitted to the next session of the Interim Commission of the WHO (1948 Budget).

V. Study tours of the Nuclear Committee on Malaria.

VI. Constitution of the Committee on Malaria of the WHO (discussion of Dr. A. Gabaldon's proposal, Doc. WHO.IC/W.27).
