PREFACE

A cumulative handbook of the resolutions and decisions of the World Health Assembly and the Executive Board has been published at intervals since 1952. The first definitive volume of this *Handbook of Resolutions and Decisions* – published in 1973 as Volume I – covered the years 1948-1972 and the second – published in 1985 as Volume II – the years 1973-1984. This third edition of Volume III covers the years 1985-1992; it brings up to date and supersedes the second edition, published in 1990.

A system of cross-references links the various sections of the present volume to the corresponding sections of Volumes I and II. Cross-references are also given when a resolution or decision deals with more than one subject, or aspects of a subject. Similarly, references to earlier volumes are given in the subject index where appropriate. The numerical index lists the pages where the full text or substance of resolutions and decisions can be found; those of a more ephemeral nature, such as procedural decisions, have been omitted.

The serial number preceding each resolution and decision shows the session at which it was adopted. For example, "WHA45.1" indicates a resolution and "WHA45(1)" a decision of the Forty-fifth World Health Assembly; while "EB90.R1" indicates a resolution and "EB90(1)" a decision of the ninetieth session of the Executive Board. A full list of these serial numbers is given on page XIII, together with the dates of the sessions and a reference to the *Official Records* volumes (up to January 1979 when the series was discontinued) or WHO documents in which the resolutions or decisions were first published.
